CIRCULAR

Protocol for 1st year and Final year Undergraduate Students for returning back to College Campus.

Objective—To facilitate, build confidence and create a safe atmosphere to students and to start regular in person theory and clinical classes at JJMMC. This protocol has been created keeping in view of guidelines set by the Government of Karnataka and ICMR.

The Guidelines are as follows:

1. Parents consent letter is mandatory and to be submitted on or before 27th November 2020 to Principal JJMMC through email principal@jjmmc.org. The hard copy of the same to be submitted to Principal office on arrival to campus. The consent form is attached
2. It is advisable for all students to undergo RTPCR testing for COVID-19 when they come to Davangere.
3. The samples for RTPCR testing will be collected in Bapuji OPD on 29th and 30th November before 2 pm
4. Alternatively, the students can have RTPCR test done at their current place and submit the report, which is not older than 3 days of your reporting to the campus.
5. Please note only if the RTPCR test comes negative the students will be allowed in to respective hostels and college.
6. It is advisable to reach Davangere before 12 noon to facilitate to obtain RTPCR test results on the same day.
7. The printed copy of RTPCR test report to be submitted to concerned hostel warden.
8. For students staying outside the hostel and day scholars the hard copy of the test report to be submitted to the Principal office JJMMC.
9. All students are strictly instructed wear mask, maintain social distance and practice hygiene and follow the guidelines issued by the ICMR/Govt. Of Karnataka for prevention and control of COVID-19. 29th and


